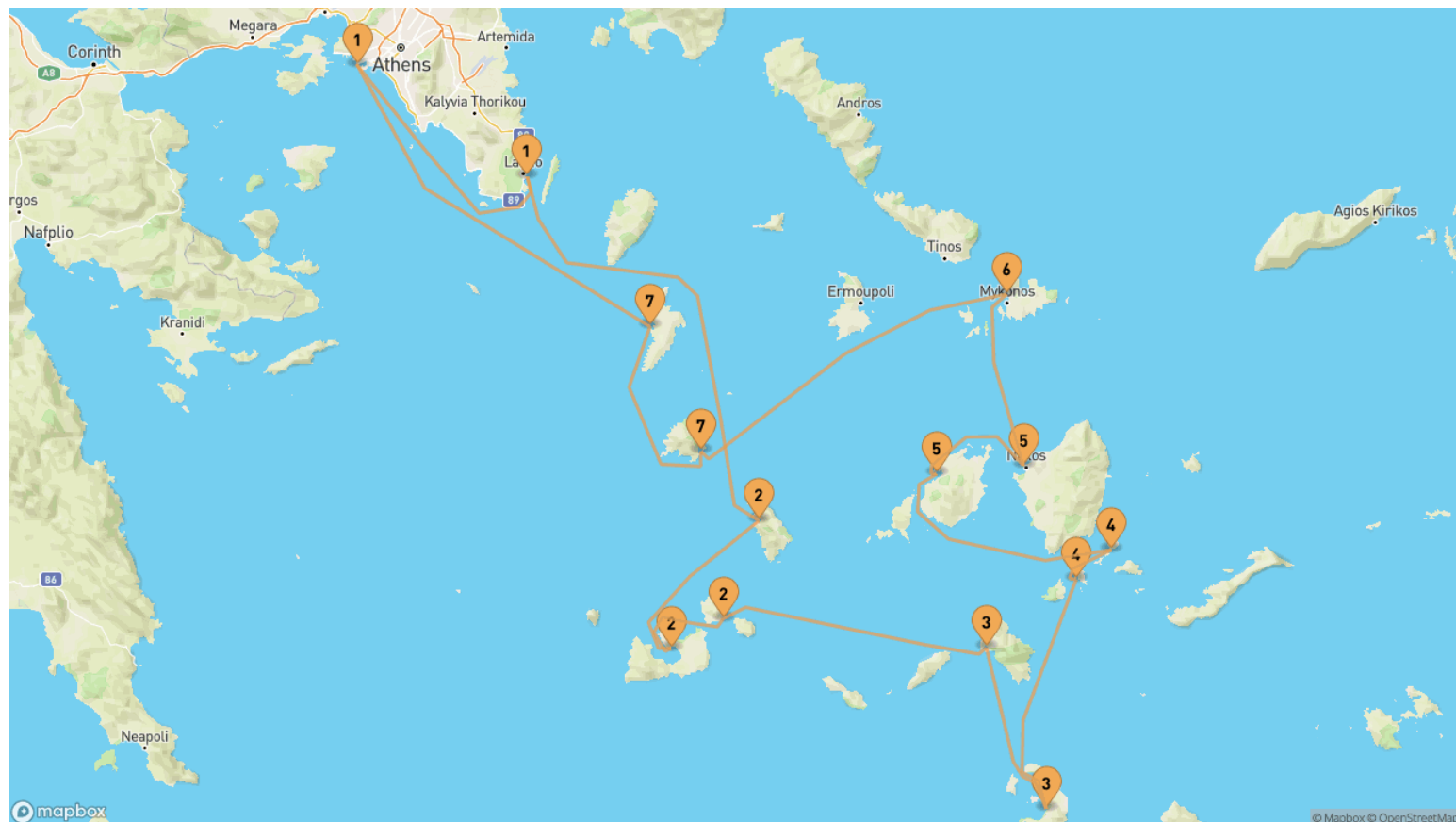


Program of cruises on Divine Cyclades

Cave

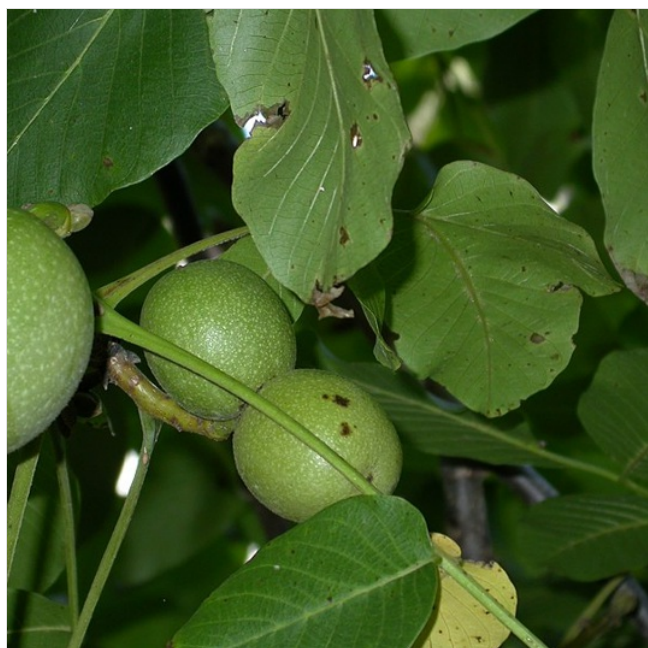
Crawl into natural wonders of Paros, like the Cave of Archilochus and Cave of the Nymphs
