






Greece / Thessaloniki

Mainland port

Greece's second city, the cultural capital. Cosmopolitan, aristocratic, it primes with the best architecture of the biggest empires in the world's history. The most Byzantian city of the present day.



Greece / Thassos

Island, Greenery, Secluded

Thassos' biggest super power is nature and tranquility. The next being traditions of old crafts.



Ancient Theatre of Thassos

Architecture, Art, Historic

Hike up to the Ancient Theater of Thassos high on a hilltop in Limenas. In the 1st century AD, the orchestra was transformed into an arena and the space was used for duels.

Gate of Zeus and Hera

Let your imagination fly at the ruins of what was the principal southern gate into the city in ancient times and the two main gate pillars had monumental reliefs portraying Zeus and Hera.



Olive Oil Museum

Learn all about olives, and what makes Thassos variety so special, in Olive Oil Museum (4) in Skala Prinos. Walk around 40 types of olive trees in the outdoor exhibition

Continue the olive theme at the mill of Sotirelli in Panagia village





Drakotrypa cave

Cave, Nature

Go for an adventure to Drakotrypa cave in Panagia, which got its name due to Stalactites and stalagmites mimicking the shape of a dragon

White Marble Quarry

Nature

See what was the foundation of many Ancient Greek monuments at the Thassos White Marble





Greece / Samothraki

Island, Greenery, Secluded

Wander through and about the island of Samothraki, covered with forests of rare flora and fauna, the origin of the Niki of Samothraki.



Sanctuary of Great Gods

Historic, Nature, Architecture

Feel the magic of the Samothrace Temple Complex, known as the Sanctuary of the Great Gods

Majestic volcanic formations, secluded groves and sheltered coves, thermal springs, tropical dunes and petrified forests.




Myrina castle

Ancient Troy


Historic, Architecture

Topkapi Palace


Historic, Architecture, Culture, Museum

The main residence of the Ottoman Sultans, with its jewel encrusted treasury of extensive and illustrious permanent collections of weaponry, precious jewels and religious artifacts

Dolmabahce Palace

Historic, Architecture

600 meters in length with 285 rooms and 43 salons



Blue Mosque

Church, Historic, Architecture, Culture

Over 20.000 hand-painted blue tiles, and more than 200 windows

Agia Sophia

Historic, Architecture, Culture

Visit the main sights around Sultanahmet Square, including the famous Agia Sophia, once the largest church in the world for 1000 years, and decorated with stunning 6th century golden mosaics.





The Grand Bazaar


Market, Historic
