



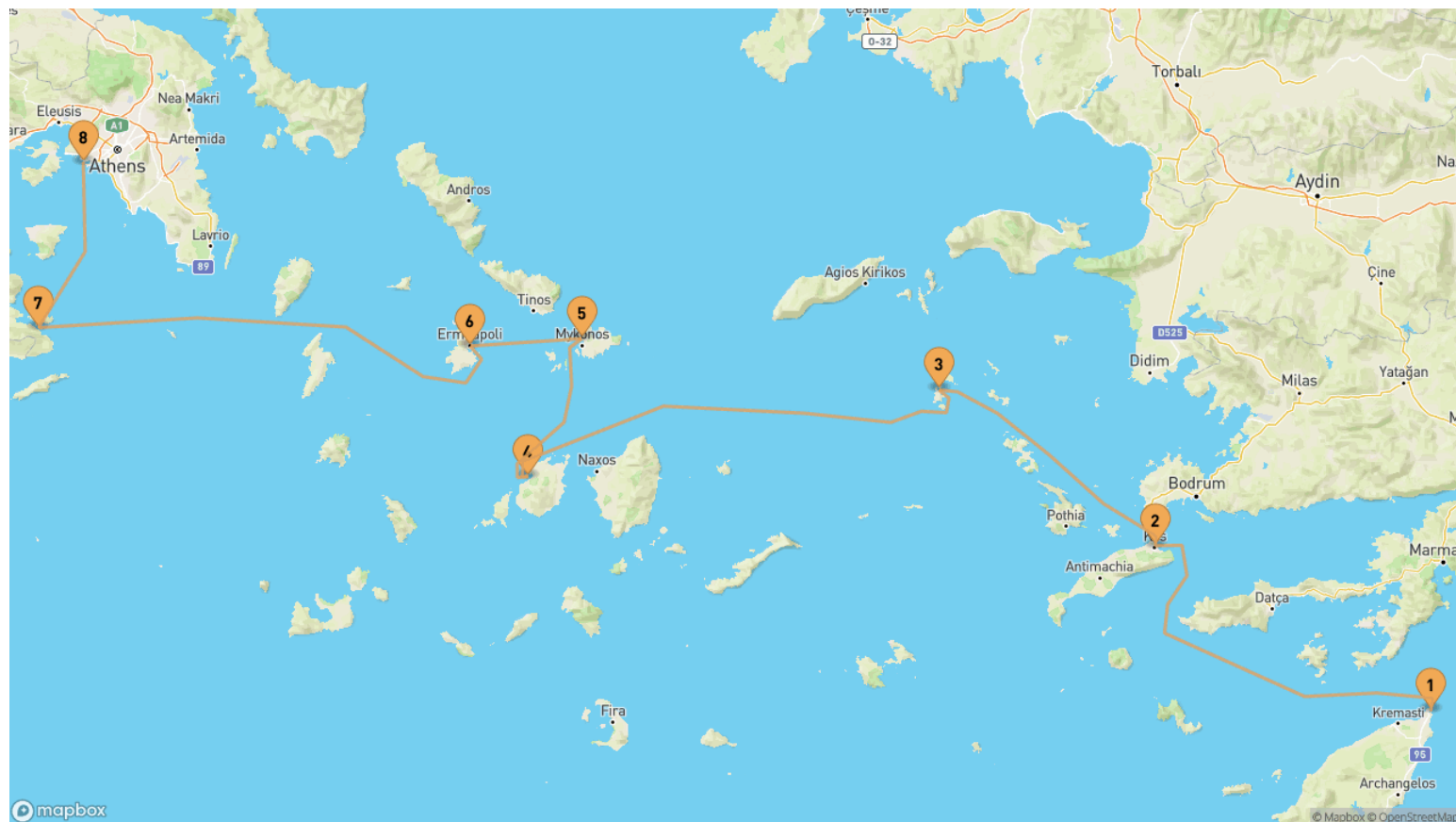

[Greece / Rhodes](#)

Island, Popular

The largest and historically the most important of the Dodecanese islands. Rhodes owes its name to the fragrant roses which grow across its plains.

Day 2



[Greece / Kos](#)

Island

Kos is referred to as the garden island among the Greek due to its geography, which allows enough rain. It is spacious and accommodates towns and mountains, flatlands and wetlands, lakes and long beaches. Kos was also home of Hippocrates, the "Father of Modern Western Medicine".

Day 3



[Greece / Patmos](#)

Island

Patmos is called the Jerusalem of the Aegean because the Apocalypse, a Christian book about the end of the World and the Church's destiny, was written here.

Day 4



[Greece / Paros-Antiparos](#)

Island

"Anti" translates in Greek not as negation but as the "opposite" of something. Islands of Paros and Antiparos lie opposite each other and are separated by a narrow strait. It is said they are the most Aegean islands among all of the Aegean. Come and see yourself why that is the case.

Day 5



[Greece / Mykonos-Delos](#)

Island, Nightlife, Popular

Star level island. Best nights out in the Aegean sea, and, perhaps, in the whole Mediterranean.
And star level cultural heritage and history, and well-preserved traditional ways of living and cooking.

Day 6



[Greece / Syros](#)

Island, Popular

The head island of all the Cyclades and Dodecaneses. The island is famous for its vast array of options for gastronomy and hidden caves and fortresses. The promenades and alleys of main towns will leave you breathless.

Day 7

Island

The Bosphorus of the Saronic with views of mainland Greece, the island wrapped with hills covered in pine trees, and surrounded by sandy beaches, with the island's capital full of small taverns.
