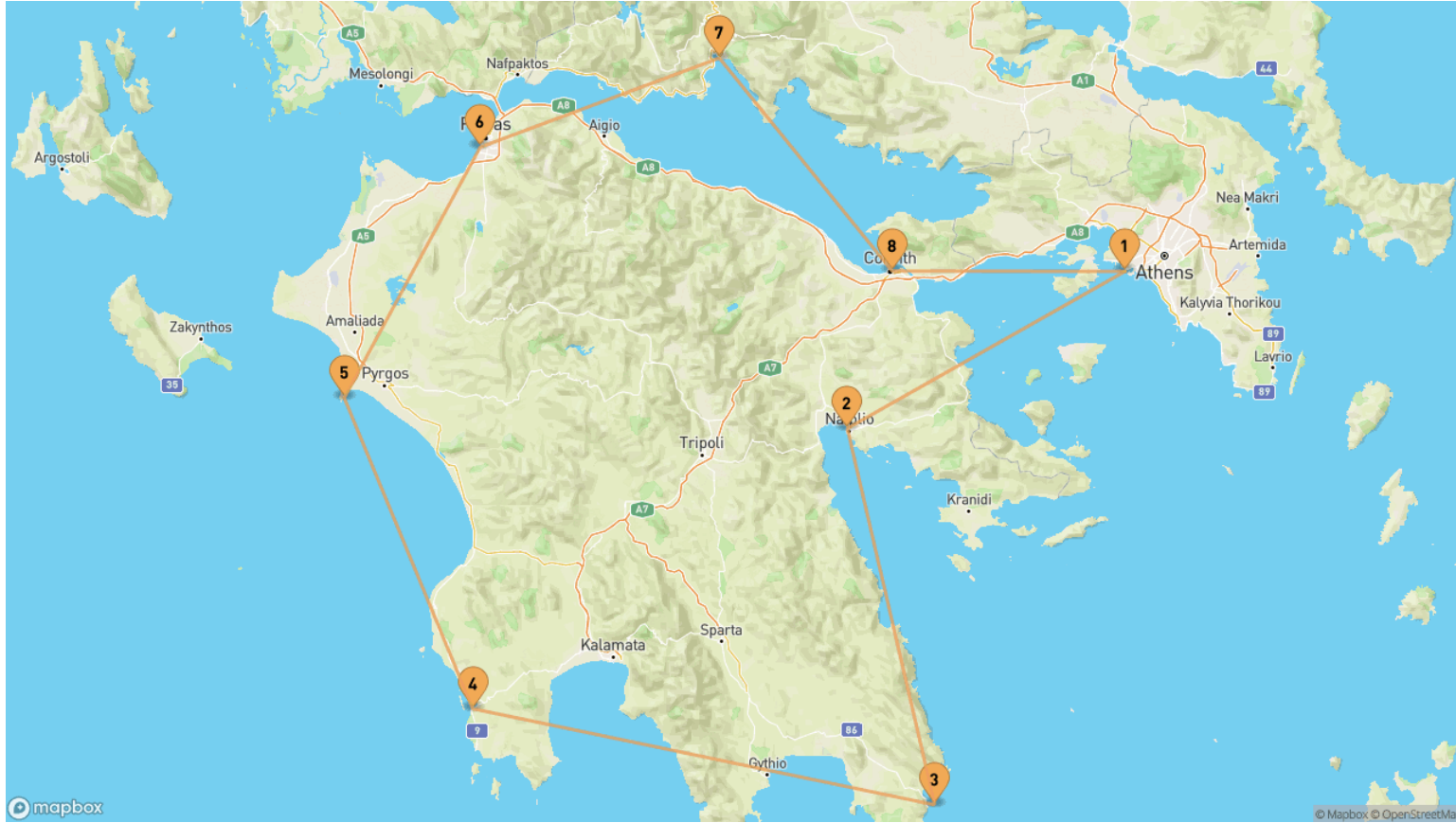

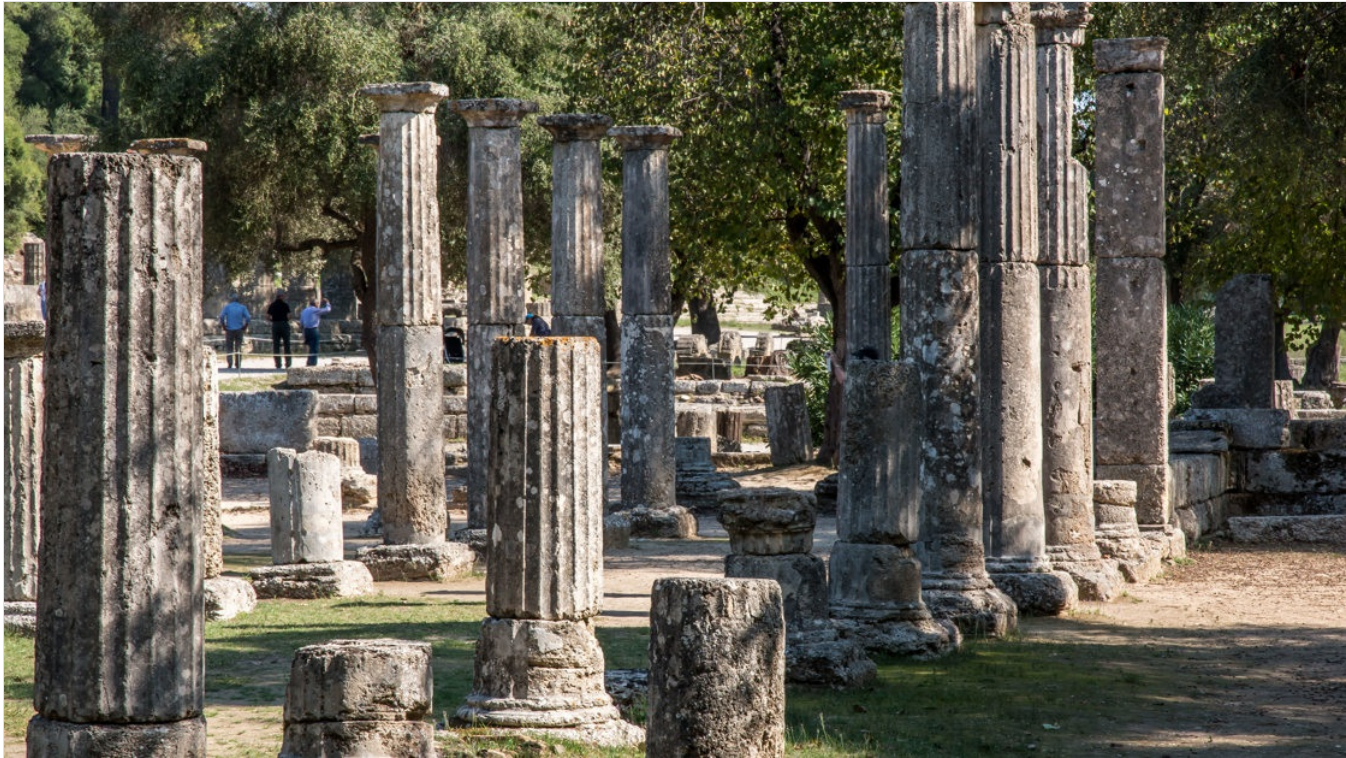


[Domaine Dereskos Winery](#)

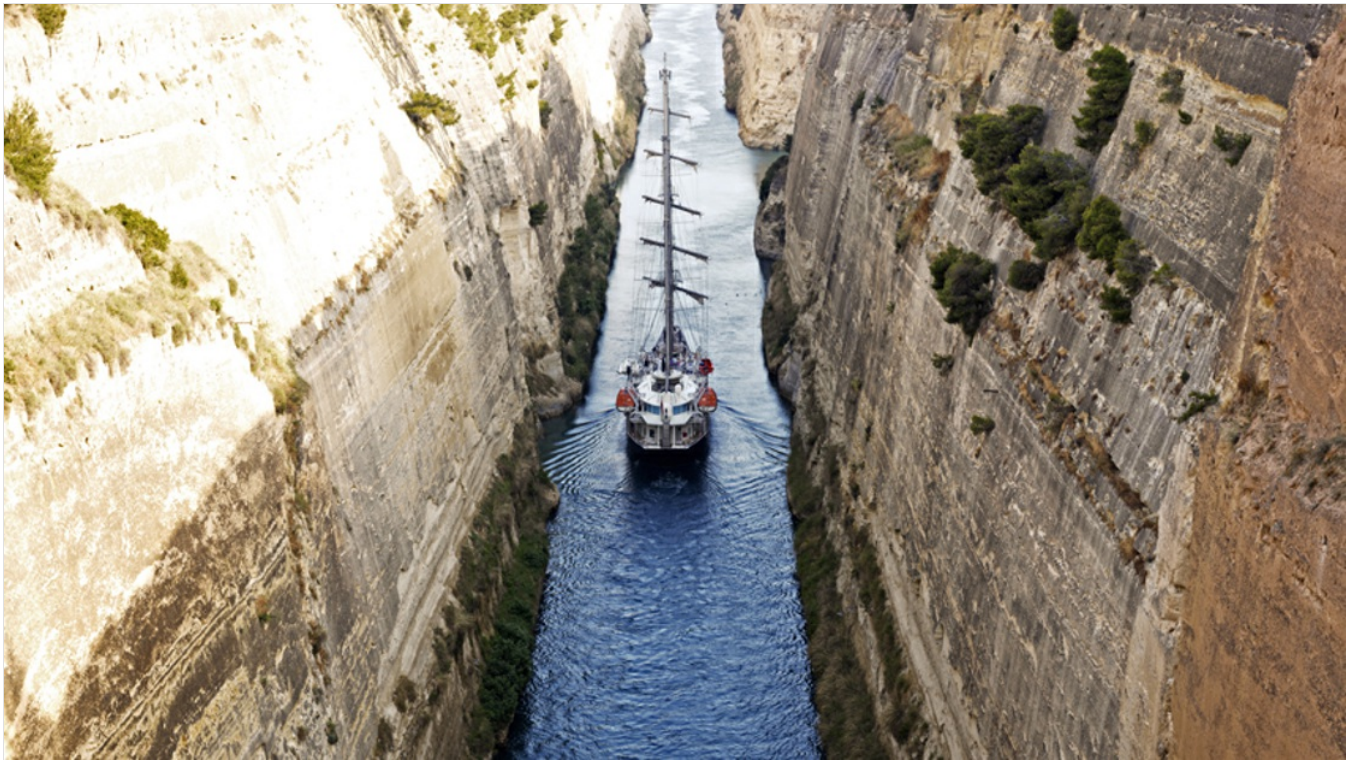


[Argyriou Winery](#)
