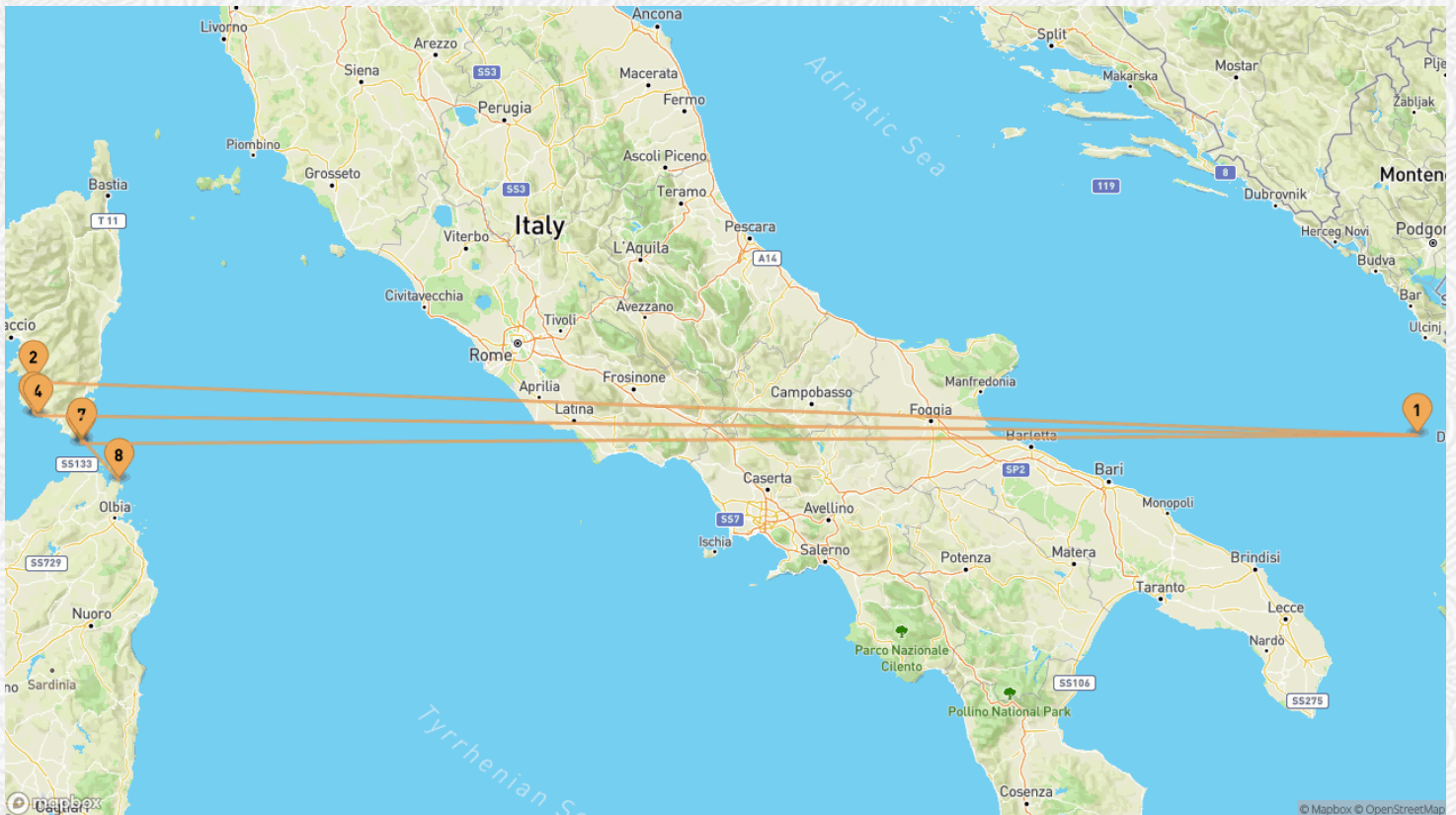


Tyrrhenian Cruise
