

Traditional, Culture, Food


Taste the famous cheese of Syros, San Mihalis



Greece / Andros

Island, Greenery

Andros is a rare Cyclades island abundant with water. It nurses dense forests, lemon groves, plane trees and rare flora. Andros accommodates mountain ranges, ravines, valleys and plateaus, and numerous cultural sites like one of the world's most impressive maritime villages, ancient cities, Hellenistic age towers, churches and others.

Greece / Tinos

Island

Tinos is the largest pilgrimage center in Greece for both Orthodox and Catholics. The island is known for its 80 or so windmills, about 1000 dovecotes, Venetian fortifications at the mountain, marble carving and famous sculptors and painters. It is charmingly old-fashioned and handicraft.

Architecture

Stroll through the capital of Tinos, Hora, a common name for Greek islands' capitals



Greece / Chios

Island

Island that flourished and received favors from other islands and cities thanks to its main symbol - mastic oil, that is available only on Chios. Mastic trees get enough love only here. Chios forests inspired many big authors and composers.



Daskolopetra stone

Historic, Nature

Marks the location where Homer gathered his students



Turkey / Cesme-Alacati

Mainland port, Town

Endless beaches, including the most beautiful one in Turkey within close reach. The province filled up with ancient sites in each direction.



Asma Yapragı

Food, Restaurant

Delicious mezes, small appetisers and olive oil dishes, and slow cooked lamb with rosemary & meatballs in cinnamon yogurt sauce
