

It is said that those who controlled Skyros controlled the trade routes to Asia Minor, mainland Greece and the kingdoms of Italy. Wild ponies are still roaming on plains and traditional craftsmen live on top of hills surrounded by pine trees.

See why Skyros owes its name to its famous Skyrian colourful stones in Skyros town, the island's capital, or Hora (meaning main town in Greek, the naming used on many islands).

Spectate at the Dionysus Festival, when shepherds, dressed as goats, dance around the cobbles of Hora.



Island


