CYCLING TO MYRTOS BEACH

Cycling: ~80 km, circular route.

Route: Argostoli Marina \rightarrow Melissani Lake \rightarrow Myrtos Beach \rightarrow Return to the ship. Elevation: ~900m.

Estimated moving time: ~3h20min.

This is a demanding ride in terms of distance and elevation.





Greece / Zakynthos

Venetians called Zakynthos the Flower of the East due to natural wonders: the Shipwreck beach, the arcade of blue caves, National Marine Park sheltering rare Caretta-Caretta turtles, thickets of cypresses, pine trees and olives and sugar-fine sand beaches. All this framed with sounds of mandolin kantades.



CYCLING TO NAVAGIO BEACH

Cycling: ~80 km, circular route.

Route: Argostoli Marina \rightarrow Melissani Lake \rightarrow Myrtos Beach \rightarrow Return to the ship. Elevation: ~900m.

Estimated moving time: ~3h20min.

This is a demanding ride in terms of distance and elevation.

Historic, Architecture

CYCLING TO OLYMPIA

Cycling: ~66km, circular route.

Route: Katakolon Marina \rightarrow Archaeological site of Ancient Olympia \rightarrow Return to the ship.

Elevation: ~147m.

Estimated moving time: ~2h40min.

High traffic.





Greece / Pylos

Mainland port

Mirriad of beaches across a vast bay, lagoon with flamingos, waterfalls, caves, castles, tombs, kayaking and diving, golf center and natural resorts - entwine activities into a hit pack in Pylos.



VOIDOKILIA BEACH

🌑 Beach

Voidokilia beach is a stunning horseshoe-shaped beach located near the town of Pylos in the southwestern part of the Peloponnese peninsula. It's known for its crystal-clear turquoise waters and golden sand. Visitors can relax and sunbathe on the beach, swim in the sea, or explore the nearby sand dunes and archaeological site of the Palace of Nestor.

NEOKASTRO

Scastle, Historic, Nature, Architecture

The fortress area also houses Transfiguration church and an Acropolis





NAVARINO BAY

Diving

The bay's floor is covered with past heroes of many naval battles. Explore remains of sunken ships.

CYCLING TO VOIDOKILIA BEACH

Cycling: ~66 km, circular route.

Route: Pilos Marina \rightarrow Costa Navarino bay \rightarrow Gialova Lagoon \rightarrow Return to the marina. Elevation: ~255m.

Estimated moving time: ~2h40min.

Narrow roads with considerable traffic.

Nainland port, Town

Nowadays Gytheio is a calm and secluded town that used to be a seaport for the legendary Sparta and Mystras



SPARTA

Historic, Architecture

Witness many ruins of legendary Sparta - once the dominant military power in Ancient Greece with effective but frightful laws, social system and constitution

CYCLING TO SPARTA

Cycling: ~45km.

Route: Gytheio Marina \rightarrow Modern and Ancient Sparta \rightarrow Transfer to the marina. Elevation: ~593m.

Estimated moving time: ~1h50min.

Central roads with heavy traffic and uphill terrain.





DIROS CAVES

Cave, Nature, View

Historical Caves with tours.

MUSEUM OF PIKOULAKIS TOWER-HOUSE -BYZANTINE MUSEUM OF MANI

Narchitecture, Culture, Historic, Museum, Traditional

Prime example of traditional Mani architecture and historical heritage. Housed in a restored 18th-century tower in Areopoli, it offers a unique experience for those interested in local history and culture.





Greece / Nafplio

Mainland port, Town

Nafplio is famous for numerous fortresses, monasteries and the Medieval Old Town. It is a perfect start point to explore ancient Mycenae, Argos and Epidaurus.



CYCLING TO MYCENAE

Cycling: ~42km, circular route. Route: Nafplio Marina → Ancient Mycenae→ Return to the marina. Elevation: ~129m. Estimated moving time: ~1h44min.

Very comfortable and easy route.

Restaurant, Nightlife, Traditional, Wine

Greece / Lavrion

Mainland port, Town

Lavrion port is a major hub for ferries and cruise ships that connect Athens with the Cyclades islands. It is situated on the southeastern coast of Attica, and it offers easy access to popular destinations like Kea, Kythnos, and Serifos. The harbor is equipped with modern facilities and services, such as cafes, restaurants, and shops, as well as a marina for private yachts.
