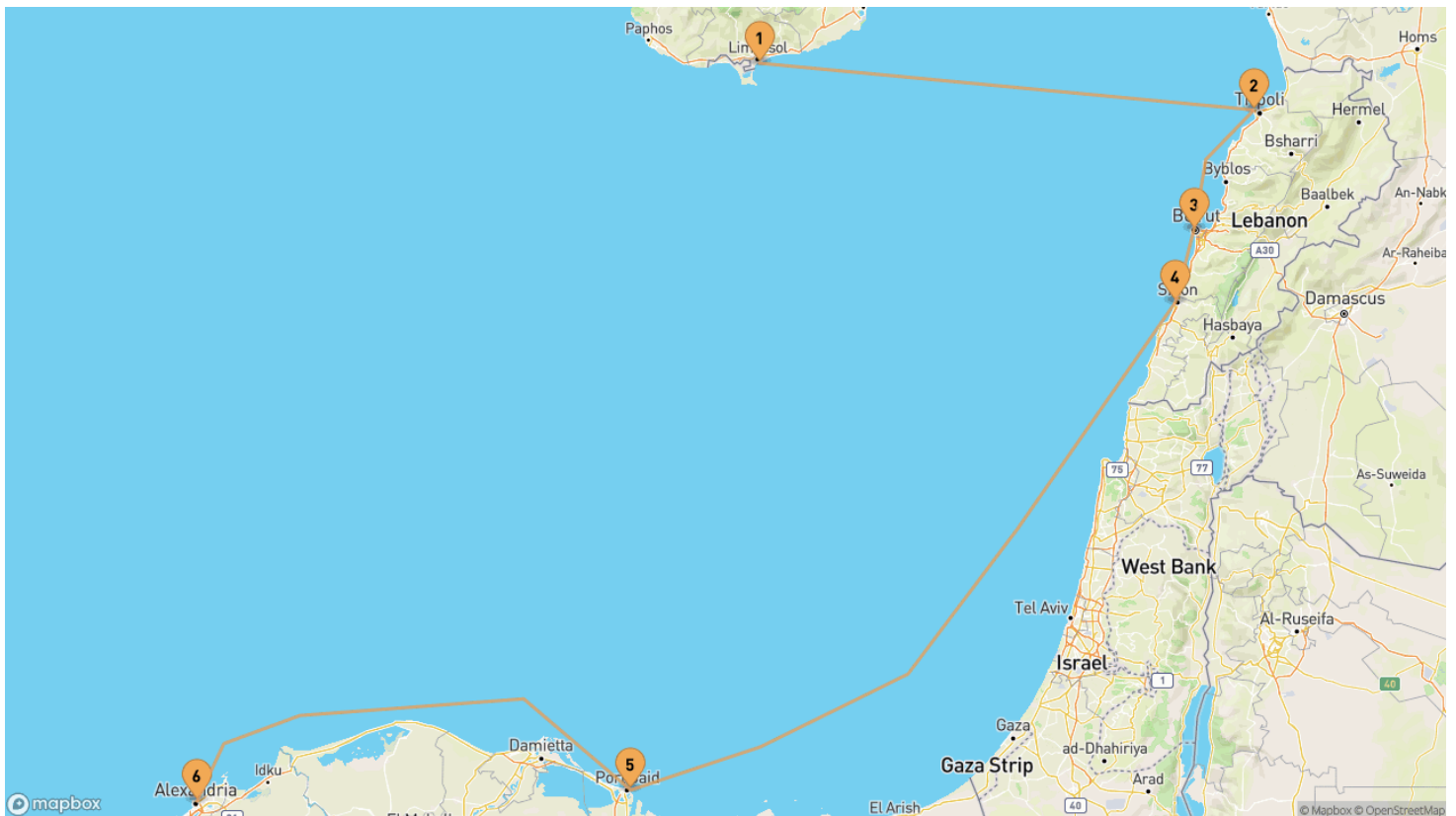


Levant Cruise
