

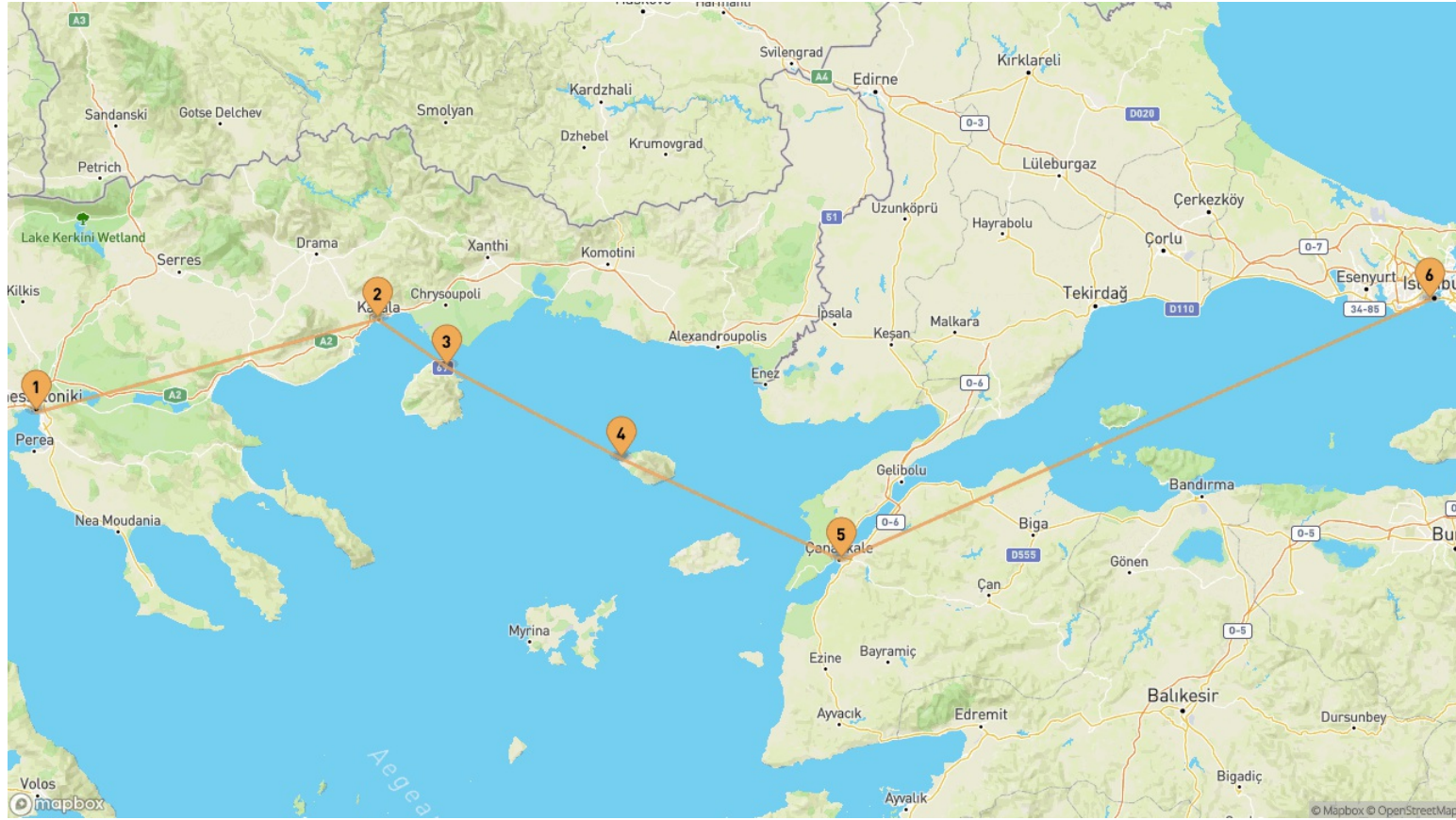

Check Roman Agora, near which you will find Rotunda of Galerius, and Arch of Galerius, carved with scenes of campaigns of Roman era

Admire the bronze statue of the iconic Greek figure in Nea Paralia District

Historic, Architecture

Transcend the wisdom of Aristotle and see his statue at his namesake square and continue along Aristotle's street

Mainland port, City

Kavala's advantageous location on the northeastern Aegean coast made it a major port city, which was founded by an expanding Thassos Island kingdom. St. Paul began his first European mission when he disembarked at Kavala.

[Ancient Theatre of Thassos](#)

Architecture, Art, Historic

Hike up to the Ancient Theater of Thassos high on a hilltop in Limenas. In the 1st century AD, the orchestra was transformed into an arena and the space was used for duels.

[Drakotrypa cave](#)

Cave, Nature

Go for an adventure to Drakotrypa cave in Panagia, which got its name due to Stalactites and stalagmites mimicking the shape of a dragon

See what was the foundation of many Ancient Greek monuments at the Thassos White Marble Quarry

Island, Greenery, Secluded

Wander through and about the island of Samothraki, covered with forests of rare flora and fauna, the origin of the Niki of Samothraki.

Feel the magic of the Samothrace Temple Complex, known as the Sanctuary of the Great Gods.

Shores on both the Asian and European sides of the Dardanelles Strait, one of the two major water passages connecting the Mediterranean and Black Sea, and joins the Aegean and Marmaris Seas.

Ride to the main attraction of the area, the site of ancient Troy with a replica of a Trojan horse



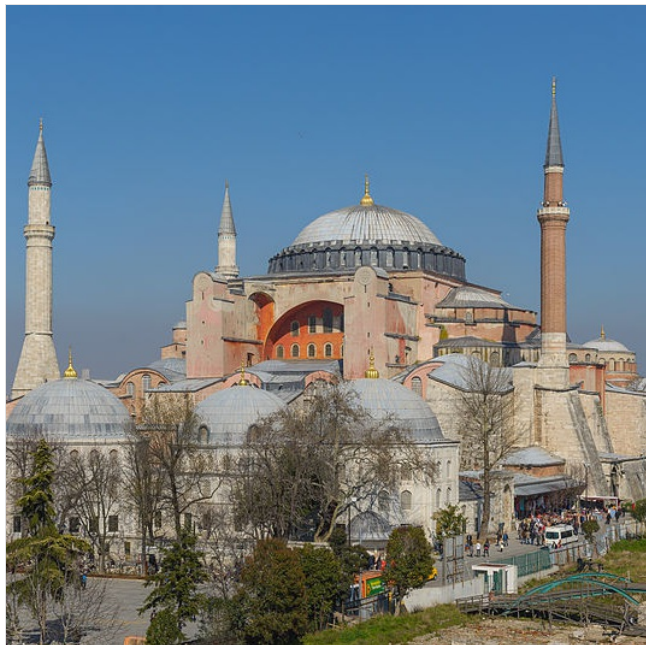
Day 6

[Agia Sophia](#)

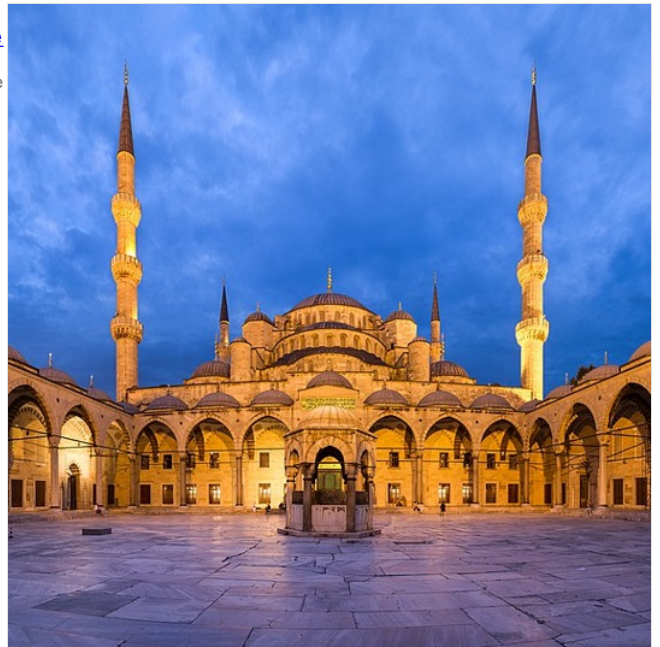
Historic, Architecture, Culture

[Dolmabahce Palace](#)

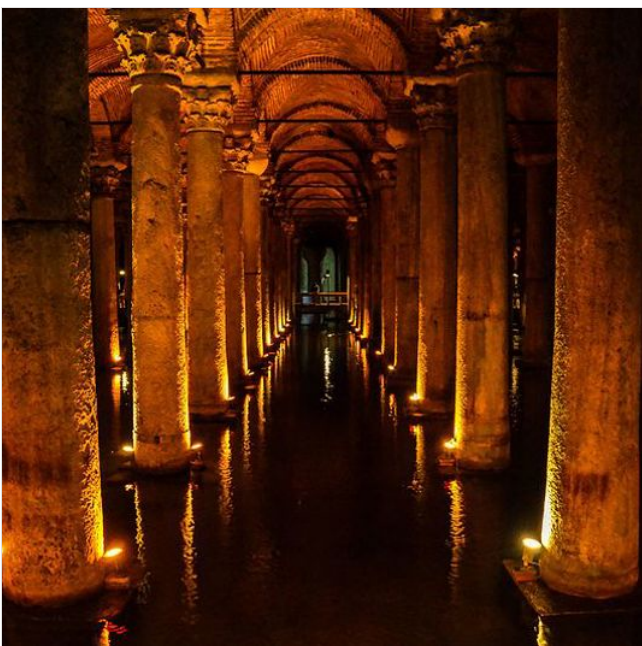
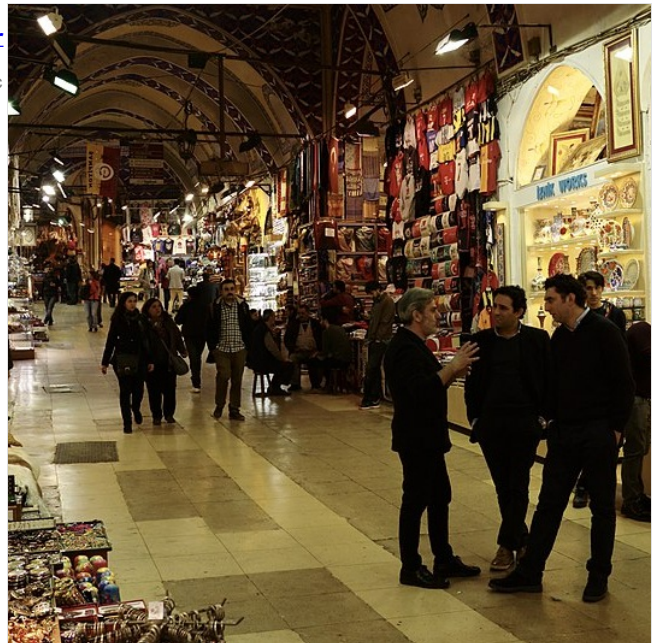
Historic, Architecture
