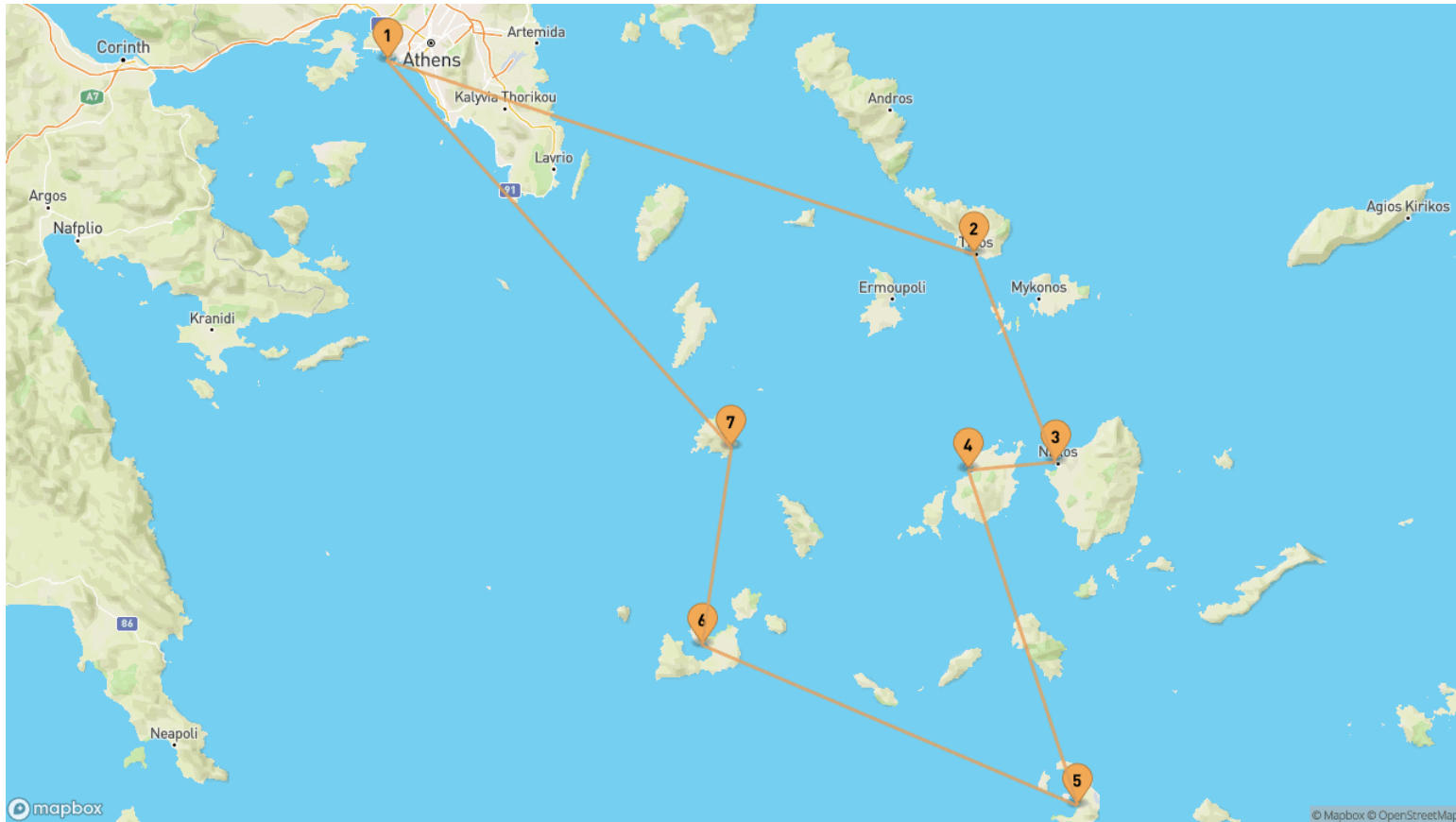




Wineries Tour Greece 2

Day 1



[Greece / Athens-Piraeus](#)

Mainland port

City where you can find a Roman tomb in the basement of the clothing store and a metro station where you can walk through the remnants of an ancient necropolis.

Day 2



[Greece / Tinos](#)

Island

Tinos is the largest pilgrimage center in Greece for both Orthodox and Catholics. The island is known for its 80 or so windmills, about 1000 dovecotes, Venetian fortifications at the mountain, marble carving and famous sculptors and painters. It is charmingly old-fashioned and handicraft.

Wine

Grapes of the vineyard are planted between the rocks. Lunar landscape with volcanoes. Malagouzia and Assirtyko grape varieties. Focus is on white wines.

Day 3



[Greece / Naxos](#)

Island, Popular

Astoundingly green with vast forests and valleys, blessed with numerous famous local produce like wine, cheese and olives, yet filled with examples of Cycladic culture.



[Saint Anna Winery](#)

Wine

Old family farming history. Current owner graduated from two large agro programs. 9th century Byzantine church of St Anna. White, rose, red, sweet and dry varieties. Fokiano, Mandilara, Monemvasia, Savvatiano – mostly Cycladic types.

Day 4



[Greece / Paros-Antiparos](#)

Island

“Anti” translates in Greek not as negation but as the “opposite” of something. Islands of Paros and Antiparos lie opposite each other and are separated by a narrow strait. It is said they are the most Aegean islands among all of the Aegean. Come and see yourself why that is the case.



[Moraitis Winery](#)

Wine

Founded in 1910, the winery is located by the beach. The property has a large line of local and classical wines, which have Protected Designation of Origin status.

Day 5



[Greece / Santorini](#)

Island, Popular, Nightlife

The island of spectacular scenery and activities. Red sand beaches, amazing views from the cliffs, traditional villages and full list of amenities.



[VSV Winery](#)

Wine

Winery's history goes back to the 18th century. It produces exclusively a single wine called 'Pure'.

Day 6



[Greece / Milos](#)

Popular, Island

Created from lava of a volcano, Milos provides staggering landscape views.
For centuries the island was the place in Greece for mining precious obsidian.
Try to find a piece of obsidian once you are there.



[Kostantakis Winery](#)

Wine

Founded in 1935. Winery is built into a cave. Assyrtiko, Monemvasia, Roditis, Savatiano, Malagousia, Mavrotragano, Mandilaria, Mavro Aidani. Award winning wines.

Day 7



[Greece / Serifos](#)

Island, Secluded

Serifos is not a very touristy island that boasts comfortable soft sand beaches, enchanting capital Hora and wild terrains.



[Chrysoloras Winery](#)

Wine

Founder lived on the island his entire life. The expression of traditionally farmed rare and local Cycladic varieties. Assyrtiko, Mandilari, Serifiotiko, Psarosyriko, Monemvasia, Roditis, Platiraho, Savatiano. Pure expression of raw power, with chunky textures.
