

Sail 800 meters by boat or even swim by yourself to a tiny island of Telendos, which is utterly peaceful, rocky, hides many caves and has just very few buildings.


[Kalymnos caves](#)

A fascinating geological formation with an underground lake that can be explored by boat.


Day 9
